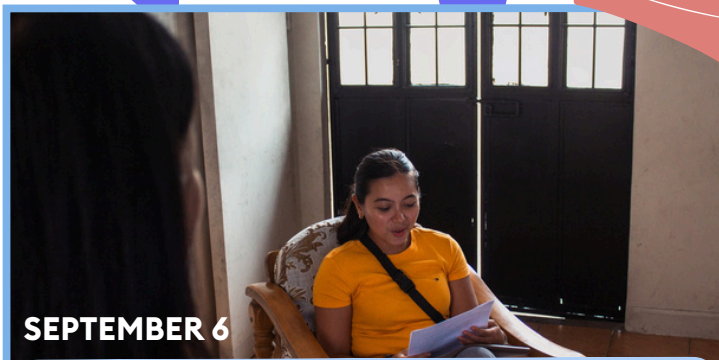

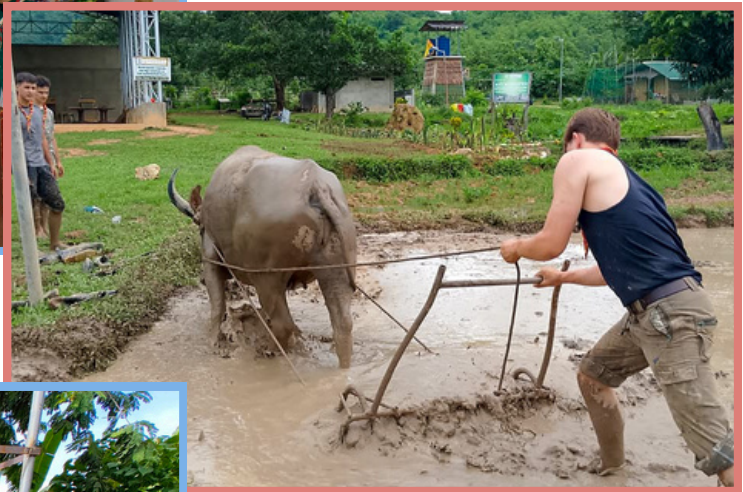




FULFILLING SUMMER FOR THE FRENCH SCOUTS AND GUIDES IN THE PHILIPPINES!

Filipino volunteers proudly wearing their Olympic uniforms and had been actively involved in the preparation of the Games contributing significantly to their success.

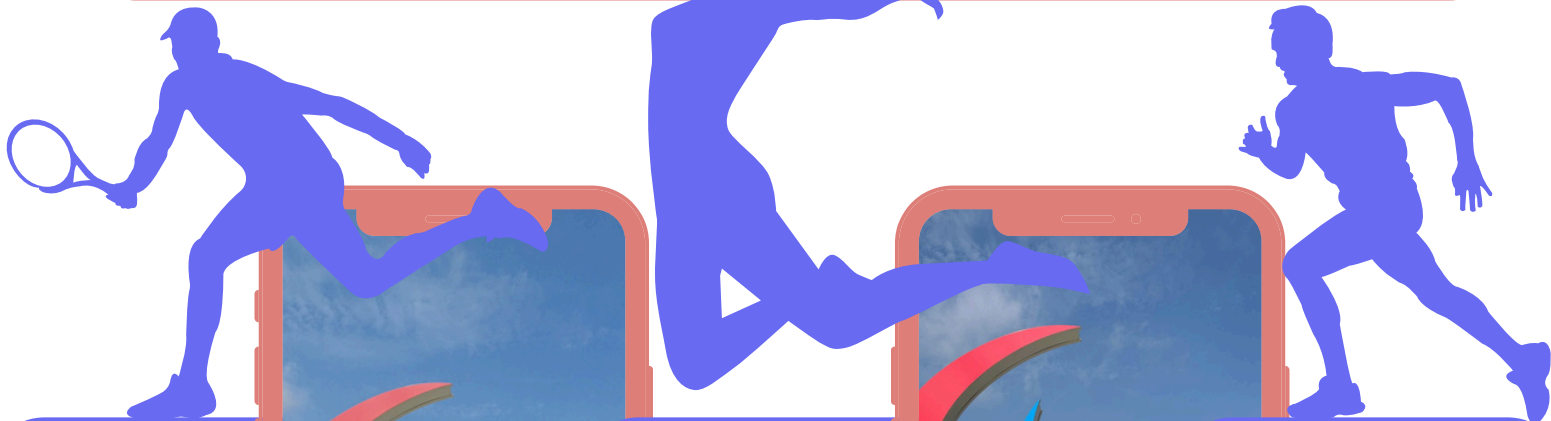
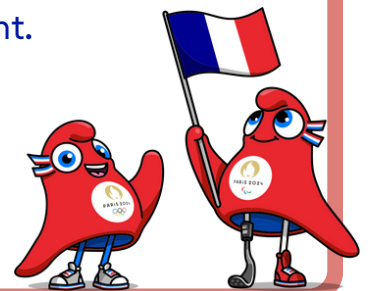




MEET THE FIVE AMAZING FILIPINO VOLUNTEERS
